Club News and Trails

Most of the work has been completed to the West of the 'top' of the Millennium on the B104. Many of you were able to see the new culverts that were placed on the B104 across the creek last season

NOW THE GOOD NEWS..

KLSC now has acquired the B104 from Norland to the Rail Line (B103) Kinmount! So as long as we get good cold weather and snow, our club will maintain this TOP TRAIL LINK. A new trail will have to be brushed soon; it is west of the new culverts.

The Heritage Trail just off of the Marsh Trail will be brushed using our volunteers that will be coming out to the chainsaw course to be held On SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 21ST @ 9:00 at the building then to the trail. To register email klsc@sympatico.ca. Volunteers are required to have a member in their group with a chainsaw operator's course to work on our trails.

NEW Large Trail Maps and Two Kiosks will be placed on our trails this season. We will try to get weatherproof "mail boxes" to hold our trail maps.

Only authorized club board members can open gates. Gates remain closed until all the necessary signage has been completed, brushing done and the trail has been groomed. Then we must send signed official trail opening forms to the OFSC to open any trail in our club or district. *Please do not open any GATES when the first snowflakes fall.... You will be violating our agreements with trail owners.*

Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs (OFSC)

THESE CONDITIONS WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS PLEASE READ CAREFULLY!

As a condition of use of OFSC Prescribed Trails, the operator or passenger of a snowmobile agrees to never leave the trail base and assumes all risk of personal injury, death or property loss resulting from any cause whatsoever including but not limited to the risks, dangers and hazards of snowmobiling; collision with natural or man made objects or other persons; travel within or beyond the authorized trail boundaries; or negligence, breach of contract or breach of statutory duty of care of the part of the Ontario Federation of Snowmobile Clubs, its member clubs, respective directors, officers, employees, volunteers, landowners, independent contractors, subcontractors, representatives, sponsors, successors and assigns (hereinafter collectively referred to as the "OFSC").

The operator or passenger of a snowmobile agrees that the OFSC shall not be liable for any such personal injury, death or property loss and releases the OFSC and waives all claims with respect thereto. The operator or passenger of a snowmobile agrees that any litigation involving the OFSC shall be brought within the exclusive jurisdiction of the court of the Province of Ontario. The operator or passenger of a snowmobile further agrees that these conditions and any rights, duties and obligations as between the OFSC and the trail permit holder shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province of Ontario and no other jurisdiction.
